# THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

#### **PART ONE - INTRODUCTION**

#### **CITATION**

**1.1** This Order shall come into operation on the [[DATE]] and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2021.

#### **INTERPRETATION**

- **1.2** Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to an article, schedule or part shall be interpreted as a reference to that article, schedule or part in this Order.
- **1.3** In this Order any reference to an Act, Statutory Instrument or Order shall be interpreted as a reference to that Act, Statutory Instrument or Order as amended.
- **1.4** In this Order the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:
  - "Bank Holiday" means a day which is a bank holiday under the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971 in England and Wales.
  - "Bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the driver) and Local Buses not so constructed or adapted.
  - "Council" means Southampton City Council.
  - "Disabled Persons Vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a valid disabled persons badge in accordance with The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.
  - "Electric Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle, intended or adapted for use on roads, which is mechanically propelled by an electric motor. This includes 'all-electric' vehicles and 'plug-in hybrid' vehicles.
  - "Local Bus" means a public service vehicle, as defined by section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981, used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour.
  - "Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.
  - "Parking Place" means the areas of land specified in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 provided as off-street parking places pursuant to Section 32(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
  - "Parking Permit" means a document issued by the Council under Part 3 of this Order which exempts a vehicle from certain parking restrictions.
  - "Pay and Display Parking Ticket" means a ticket which shows that a payment has been made of an amount or for a specified period of time and specifies the time of such payment or the time at which the vehicle must leave the Parking Place.
  - "Public Holiday" means a public holiday in England and Wales.
  - "Ticket Machine" means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for Transport for the purpose of indicating the time by a clock and for the issuing of Parking Tickets.

#### **PART TWO - PARKING PLACES**

#### **USE OF PARKING PLACES**

- **2.1** A Parking Place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving of any vehicle except those of a class or type specified in column 9 of schedule 1.
- **2.2** A vehicle left in a Parking Place must be parked wholly within a marked parking bay (if provided).
- 2.3 No vehicle other than a Disabled Persons Vehicle shall be left within a parking bay marked and/or signed as being for use by Disabled Persons Vehicles.
- **2.4** No vehicle other than an Electric Vehicle being recharged shall be left within a parking bay marked and/or signed as being for recharging Electric Vehicles.
- 2.5 Where a parking bay or area is marked and/or signed as being for use by a specific vehicle or class of vehicle, no other vehicle or vehicle not of that class shall be left within that parking bay or area.
- **2.6** No vehicle shall be left in a position which prevents access or which obstructs other vehicles.
- 2.7 The driver of a motor vehicle using a Parking Place must stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position and must not start the engine except to change the position of the vehicle or depart from the Parking Place.
- 2.8 Unless the prior written consent of the Council is obtained no person shall use any part of a Parking Place or a vehicle left in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of any goods or services.
- 2.9 No person shall use any part of a Parking Place or a vehicle left in a Parking Place as for any domestic or sanitary purpose including but not limited to sleeping, camping, cooking, bathing or cleaning.
- **2.10** No person shall cause or permit any repair or maintenance works to be carried out to a vehicle left in a Parking Place except where necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the Parking Place.

#### SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES

- **2.11** The Council or any person so authorised by the Council may suspend use of any Parking Place or part of a Parking Place.
- 2.12 Unless the prior written consent of the Council is obtained no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in a Parking Place or part of a Parking Place which has been suspended.
- **2.13** The Council may suspend any provision of this Order at its complete discretion.

#### **REMOVAL OF VEHICLES**

- **2.14** Where a vehicle is in contravention of article 2.6 or article 2.12 the Council or any person so authorised by the Council or a Police Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer may remove the vehicle or arrange for the vehicle to be removed from the Parking Place in any manner as they consider necessary.
- **2.15** Any person removing or arranging for a vehicle to be removed under article 2.14 shall make such arrangement as reasonably necessary for the reasonable safe custody of that vehicle.

#### **PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING**

2.16 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Pay & Display" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, unless:

- (a) the appropriate charge for the length of stay, as specified in schedule 2 in accordance with the relevant parking tariff specified in column 4 of schedule 1, has been paid; or
- (b) a valid Parking Permit is displayed in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, or
- (c) The vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle left in one of the following car parks: Amoy Street, Bevois Valley Road, Bond Street, Civic Centre Forecourt, College Street, Compton Walk, Crosshouse Hard, Gloucester Square, Handford Place, James Street, Mayflower Park, Northam Road, Ordnance Road, Six Dials, Southampton Street, The Quays North, The Quays South, Toys R Us North, Toys R Us South, Trinity Road, West Park (MSCP) and Wilton Avenue.
- **2.17** The charge described in article 2.16 shall be payable by:
  - (a) the insertion into a Parking Meter which relates to the on-street parking place of coins or notes (where such a facility is available); or
  - (b) credit or debit card at a Parking Meter which relates to the on-street parking place (where such a facility is available); or
  - (c) use of a pay by phone, pay by text or pay by app system (where such a facility is available).
- 2.18 Where a Pay and Display Parking Ticket has been issued from a Parking Meter it must be displayed; in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle. Multiple Tickets' shall not be displayed.
- **2.19** The time at which the length of stay paid for will expire shall be as specified:
  - (a) on the Pay and Display Parking Ticket issued by the Parking Meter; or
  - (b) on a hand-held device which indicates when a charge has been paid by phone, text or app.
- 2.20 A Pay and Display Parking Ticket shall cease to be valid at the time specified on it.
- **2.21** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Pay & Display" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, after the expiry of the length of stay paid for.
- **2.22** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Pay & Display" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, for longer than the period of time specified in column 7 of Schedule 1 unless that vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle.
- 2.23 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Pay & Display" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, to return to the same Parking Place within the period of time specified in column 8 of schedule 1 unless that vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle.

#### PAY ON FOOT PARKING

2.24 Those Parking Places specified as "Pay on foot" in column 5 of schedule 1 shall be controlled by barriers at the entry and exit points. The driver of a vehicle shall gain entry by taking a ticket at the entry barrier. This ticket shall be submitted to a pay station at the end of the parking period and validated by payment of the appropriate charge for the length of stay, as specified in schedule 2 in accordance with the relevant parking tariff specified in column 4 of schedule 1. The validated ticket shall then be used to operate the exit barrier.

2.25 In the event that the driver of a vehicle is unable to produce a ticket through loss or any other cause whatsoever he may obtain a validated ticket by payment at a pay station of a charge equal to the charge for the longest stay permitted for each charging period that the vehicle has been left in the Parking Place.

#### SHOPMOBILITY PARKING

- **2.26** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Shopmobility" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, unless:
  - (a) a valid Parking Permit is displayed in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

#### **PART THREE - PERMITS**

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PARKING PERMITS**

3.1 Any person, partnership or body corporate who meets the criteria specified in column 4 of schedule 3 shall be eligible for a Parking Permit of the type specified in column 1 of schedule 3.

#### APPLICATION FOR PARKING PERMITS

- 3.2 An application for a Parking Permit must be made in the manner specified by the Council.
- **3.3** The Council may require an applicant to produce such evidence as considered necessary to verify the information provided as part of the application.

#### ISSUE OF PARKING PERMITS

- 3.4 On receipt of an application made under the provisions of this Order the Council and payment of the relevant charge as specified in column 2 of schedule 3, upon being satisfied that the applicant is eligible and meets all relevant requirements may issue a Parking Permit, subject to any limits that the Council considers appropriate on the overall number of permits issued, the number of permits issued for use in a particular Parking Place or the number of permits issued to a particular business.
- **3.5** The charge for the issue of each Parking Permit shall be as specified in column 2 of schedule 3, valid for the length of time specified in column 3 of schedule 3.
- 3.6 A duplicate Parking Permit may be issued by the Council if the original Parking Permit has been lost, stolen, or becomes mutilated, defaced, faded, discoloured or otherwise illegible.
- **3.7** The Council reserves the right to vary the policy, charges and terms for the issue of a Parking Permit as it considers appropriate and may provide written notice of any such variation as it considers appropriate.
- **3.8** Notwithstanding the preceding articles, the issuing of Parking Permits is at the complete discretion of the Council and exceptional issues of Parking Permit may be undertaken as the Council considers appropriate.

#### **VALIDITY OF PARKING PERMITS**

- **3.9** A Parking Permit shall not be valid when used:
  - (a) within any Parking Place other than those specified in Schedule 4
  - (b) in contravention of conditions of use specified in column 5 of schedule 3.
- **3.10** A Parking Permit shall cease to be valid in the following circumstances:
  - (a) After the expiry date specified on it

- (b) The parking permit holder ceases to be eligible for the parking permit
- (c) The withdrawal of the Parking Permit by the Council
- (d) A duplicate Parking Permit is issued by the Council.

#### WITHDRAWAL AND SURRENDER OF PARKING PERMITS

- **3.11** A Parking Permit holder may surrender a Parking Permit to the Council at any time.
- **3.12** A Parking Permit holder must surrender a Parking Permit to the Council in the circumstances specified in article 3.10.
- 3.13 The Council may serve notice of the withdrawal of a parking permit in writing to the parking permit holder at the address given on the application or at any other address believed to be the parking permit holders residence or place of business; on receipt of this notice the parking permit holder shall surrender the Permit to the Council within 14 days.

#### FORM OF PARKING PERMITS

- **3.14** A Parking Permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
  - (a) An indication of the type of Parking Permit
  - (b) The expiry date of the Parking Permit
  - (c) An indication that the Parking Permit was issued by the Council

#### **DISPLAY OF PARKING PERMITS**

3.15 A Parking Permit must be displayed in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen on the inside surface of the windscreen so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle or in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

#### PART FOUR - EXEMPTIONS

#### **GENERAL EXEMPTIONS**

- **4.1** Nothing in this Order shall prohibit any vehicle from waiting, stopping or parking for as long as necessary in the following circumstances:
  - (a) The vehicle is directed to wait or stop by or with the permission of a Police Officer or Civil Enforcement Officer
  - (b) The vehicle is being used for fire and rescue authority (within the meaning of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004), ambulance (including providing a response to an emergency at the request of an NHS ambulance service), bomb or explosive disposal, special forces, police or National Crime Agency purposes and the observance of a provision of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used
  - (c) Where the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or in order to prevent an accident
  - (d) The vehicle cannot be moved due to an unavoidable breakdown

#### **SPECIFIC EXEMPTIONS**

**4.2** Articles 2.16, 2.21, 2.22 and 2.23 shall not apply to a Bus parked within the bus parking bays in the Mayflower park car park. Buses may park for up to 10 hours without charge.

# **PART FIVE - CONTRAVENTION & REVOCATIONS**

### **CONTRAVENTION**

**5.1** Any person or vehicle failing to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be in contravention of it and a penalty charge shall be payable.

### **REVOCATIONS**

- **5.2** The following orders shall be revoked in their entirety:
  - (a) The City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019.
