## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (SHIRLEY ROAD) (CYCLE FACILITIES) NOTICE 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following cycle tracks:

LOCATION:	PERMITTED USE:
<b>Shirley Road Footways</b> , south-west side, From of its junction with Harold Road to its junction with of Nightingale Grove	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Shirley Road Footways</b> , south-west side, From 16m north-west its junction with Cawte Road to 3m south-east of its junction with Cawte Road.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Shirley Road Footways</b> , north-east side, From 4m north-west of the north-western kerblineline of Malmesbury Road to 42m north-west of the north-western kerblineline of Howard Road.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Malmesbury Road Footways</b> , north-west side, From its junction with Shirley Road Footways north-eastwards for 13m.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Malmesbury Road</b> , continuous footway across Malmesbury Road at its junction with Shirley Road.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Dyer Road</b> , continuous footway across Dyer Road at its junction with Shirley Road.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
<b>Cawte Road</b> , continuous footway across Cawte Road at its junction with Shirley Road.	pedal cycles and on foot (shared use)
Note: Some section of footway will be widened where required to ensure a minimum cycle track width of 3m.
