THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (SHIRLEY ROAD) ORDER 2021

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1 This Order shall come into operation on [[DATE]] and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Shirley Road) Order 2021.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" shall mean the City of Southampton (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2011, as amended.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

- 3 The contents of Schedule 1 shall be deleted from Schedule 2.01 to the Principal Order.
- 4 The contents of Schedule 2 shall be inserted into Schedule 2.01 to the Principal Order.
- 5 The contents of Schedule 3 shall be deleted from Schedule 6.01 to the Principal Order.
- 6 The contents of Schedule 4 shall be inserted into a new Schedule 7.06 of the Principal Order
- 7 Article 8(iii) of the Principle Order shall be deleted and replaced as follows;
 - (iii) (a) Save as provided in sub-paragraphs (e) and (f) below, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left between the hours of 8am and 6pm. Monday to Saturday on any day in any part of a parking place specified in Schedule 7.09 for longer than 30 minutes
 - (b) Save as provided in sub-paragraphs (e) and (f) below, no person shall cause or permit vehicle to be left between the hours of 7am and 10am on any day in any part of a parking place specified in Schedule 7.09.
 - (b) Save as provided in sub-paragraphs (e) and (f) below, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left between the hours of 8am and 1pm on any day in any part of a parking place specified in Schedule 7.10.
 - (c) Save as provided in sub-paragraphs (e) and (f) below, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left between the hours of 7am 10am Monday to Friday in any part of a parking place specified in Schedule 7.11.
 - (d) Nothing in sub-paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) above shall apply to a goods vehicle or heavy goods vehicle waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle:

PROVIDED THAT the vehicle shall not so wait for a period of more than one hour or if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that parking place.

- (e) Nothing in sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) above shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any parking place:
 - (I) for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (II) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with a wedding or funeral provided that the vehicle can be reasonably used for that purpose only from the road;
 - (III) for so long as may be necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed;
 - (IV) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, if it cannot be so used without waiting in the said road or parking place:

building, industrial or demolition operations;

the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said length or road or side of roads;

the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of road or side of roads of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;

the services of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or

the posting or removing of advertising material in the form of posters.

- (V) if the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (VI) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident; or
- (VII) if the vehicle is displaying in a prominent position behind the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be entirely and easily seen from the front of the vehicle a valid waiver certificate and is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions prescribed by the said certificate.
