## PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

- A. To introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions in the following lengths of road:
  - **1. Bath Road**, *north-west side*, From 10m south-west to 10m north-east of its junction with Bath Close.
  - 2. Bath Close, both sides, From its junction with Bath Road north-westwards for 10m.
  - 3. **Bishops Crescent (Spine)**, *both sides*, From the south-eastern kerbline of Bishops Road south-eastwards for 10m.
  - 4. **Bishops Road**, *south-east side*, From 10m south-west to 10m north-east of its junction with Bishops Crescent (Spine).
  - 5. **Liverpool Street**, *east side*, From 36.5m north of its junction with Middle Street northwards for 3m.
  - Waterloo Road, south side, From its junction with Shirley Road westwards to the boundary between 14/16 Waterloo Road.
    Wessex Lane, north-west side, From 25m north of its junction with Woodmill Lane north-eastwards for 22m.
- **B.** To introduce No Waiting 8am 6pm Monday to Friday restrictions in **Victoria Road**, *west side*, From 10m north of its junction with Keswick Road north-eastwards for 18m.
- **C.** To introduce Parking Places with 1 Hour Limit (No Return within 1 Hour) 8am 6pm Monday to Saturday restrictions in **Seagarth Lane**, *west side*, From 52m south of the extended south-eastern kerbline of Seagarth Close southwards for 24m.
- D. To update the existing traffic orders to align with the restrictions as marked on street, in the following roads: Above Bar Street, Portland Terrace, Service Road behind 85-89 Commercial Road & St Mary Street
