MODIFICATION TO PROPOSED THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (RESIDENTS PARKING) (AMENDMENT 20) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL intends to modify the above proposed Order. The proposals for Somerset Road would be replaced with the following:

- To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in **Somerset Road**, *east side*, From 68m 1. south of the southern kerb-line of Brickfield Road southwards to the northern boundary of 17 Somerset Road.
- To introduce Parking Places with 2 Hour limit (No Return Same Day) 8am 6pm Monday to 2. Friday Except Permit Holders restrictions in Somerset Road, west side, From 10m south of the southern kerb-line of Brickfield Road southwards for 52m and From 92m south of the southern kerb-line of Brickfield Road southwards for 61m; east side, From northern boundary of 17 Somerset Road to 10m north of the north-eastern kerbline of Welbeck Avenue.
- To introduce Parking Places with 4 Hour limit (No Return Same Day) 8am 6pm Monday to 3. Friday Except Permit Holders restrictions in Somerset Road, east side, From 10m south of the southern kerb-line of Brickfield Road southwards for 58m.

Note existing restrictions marked on-street will remain.
