THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (RESIDENTS PARKING) (ZONES 1-12 & 16) (AMENDMENT 20) ORDER 2020

Statement of Reasons

This restrictions in this Order are being proposed for the following reasons:

- Permit Parking restrictions in response to local resident concerns over the shortage of on-street parking, to improve the amenity of the area
- No waiting at any time restrictions for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising or for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- Time limited parking to allow visitor parking in the vicinity of allotments and school in Somerset Road, to preserve the amenity of the area
- In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
