## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL intends to make the following amendments to the above Order, advertised on the 18<sup>th</sup> June 2021, the effects of which would be:

- **A.** To introduce Parking Places with 1 Hour Limit 8am-10pm (No Return within 1 Hour) restrictions in **Victoria Road**, west side, From 10m north of its junction with Keswick Road north-eastwards for 18m.
- **B.** To introduce No Waiting 8am-6pm Mon-Fri restrictions in **Seagarth Lane**, *west side*, From 52m south of the extended south-eastern kerbline of Seagarth Close southwards for 24m.
- C. To update the existing traffic orders to align with the restrictions as marked on street, in **Victoria Road.**

To account for these changes and to allow for any additional comments and responses, the consultation has been extended by a week, closing on the 16<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

Note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
