NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following shared-use cycle tracks (permitted use on foot and pedal cycle):

- 1. Lower Brownhill Road Footways and Verges: From the Portelet House footpath south-westwards and north-westwards to Lower Brownhill Way, approximately 20m north-east of the extended eastern kerbline of Frogmore Lane.
- 2. **Colne Avenue Footways and Lower Brownhill Road Verges**, From Colne Avenue eastwards for 7m
- 3. Lower Brownhill Road Footways (spur) (west), both sides, for their entire length (excluding the section of footway at the closed end).
- 4. Lower Brownhill Way Road Footway, south side, From its junction with Lower Brownhill Road Footways (spur) (west) north-westwards for 10m
- 5. Lower Brownhill Road Footways and Verges, south side, From its junction with Lower Brownhill Road (spur) (west) north-eastwards for 43m
- 6. Brownhill Way, Lower Brownhill Road and Frogmore Lane Islands.
