## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST MARYS ROAD) (CYCLE FACILITIES) (PHASE 2) NOTICE 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following cycle tracks:

| <b>St Mary's Road Footway</b> , <i>west side</i> , From its junction with Onslow Road southwards for 70m   | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |

| <b>St Mary's Road Footway</b> , <i>west side</i> , From the northern end of the layby outside of D'Cent Cutz barbers, northwards to 130m south of its junction with Onslow Road    | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>Charlotte Place Roundabout Footways</b> , <i>south side</i> , From its junction with St Mary's Road westwards to 5m south of the Crossing connecting Charlotte Place roundabout | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>Charlotte Place Roundabout Footways</b> , <i>north side</i> , The section adjacent to the Crossing connecting Charlotte Place Roundabout  | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>Charlotte Place Roundabout Footways</b> , <i>north side</i> , From its junction with St Mary's Road Footways westwards for 10m  | On pedal cycles only<br>(See note below) |
| <b>Brinton's Terrace Footways</b> , <i>north side</i> , From its junction with St Mary's Road eastwards for 16m  | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>St Mary's Road Footway</b> , <i>east side</i> , From its junction with Brinton's Terrace northwards to the end of the Pedestrian Crossing area                                  | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>St Mary's Road Footway</b> , <i>east side</i> , From 10m south of its junction with Brinton's Terrace southwards for 17m  | on pedal cycles and on foot (shared use) |
| <b>Note:</b> Footways and verges proposed for pedal cycles only will be two-way segregated cycle tracks. An associated route for pedestrians will also be provided.                |  |
