

**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST DENYS) (ACTIVE TRAVEL ZONE)
(PHASE 3) ORDER 2021**

Statement of Reasons

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic
- For avoiding the danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

Active Travel Zones (ATZ) in local neighbourhoods seek to improve local areas by implementing measure that would encourage people to walk and cycle, in turn creating an environment that is attractive and social.

Phase 3 of the ATZ sees the introduction of traffic calming build-outs at the junctions of Priory and Aberdeen Road and on Dundee Road at its northern end and a section immediately north of its junction with North Road. To prevent obstruction and improve safety around these build-outs no waiting at any time restrictions are being proposed.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s122 subsection (2) of that Act).
