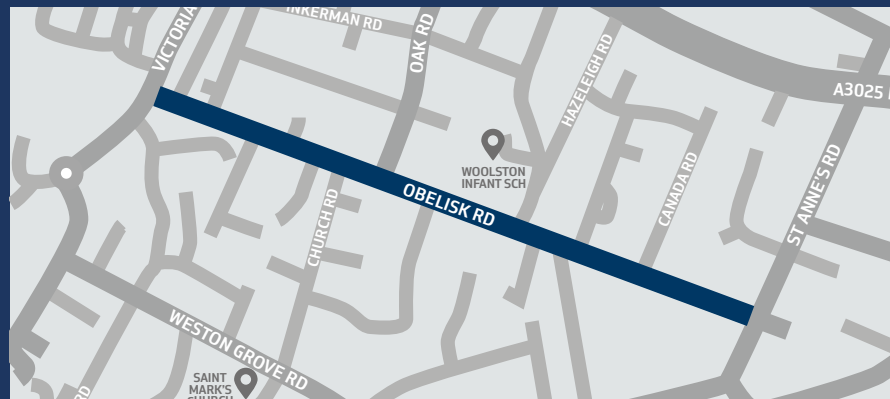

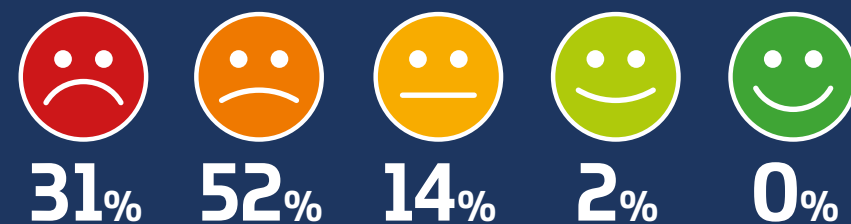

How Obelisk Road makes you feel

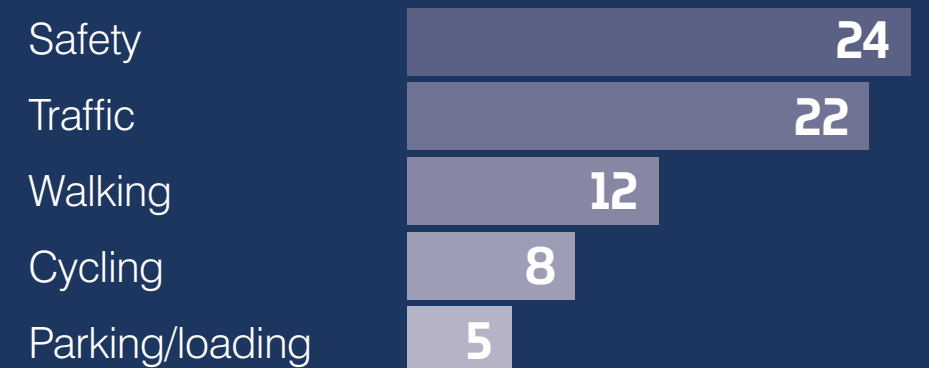


Relationship with area

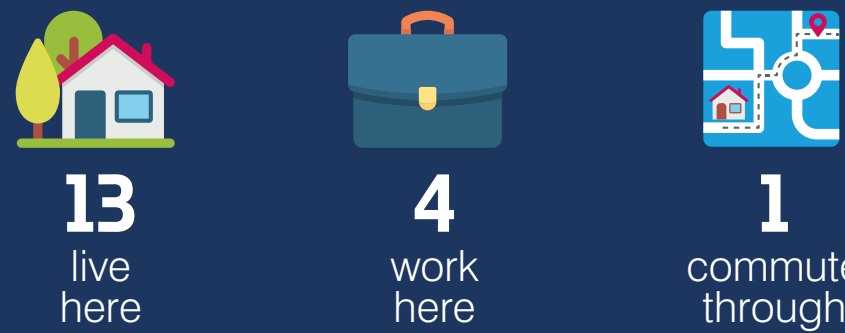

Relationship with area

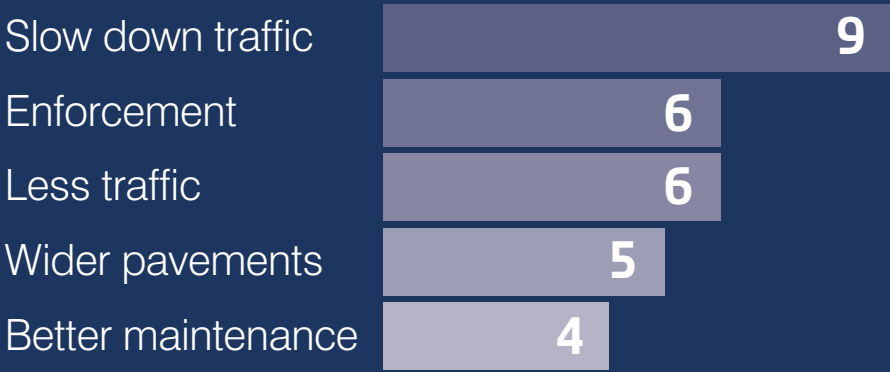


“ This road is used as a rat run with heavy traffic throughout the day at fast speed. Drivers are always abusing the one way system and drive extremely fast down this residential street. ”

What would you change?

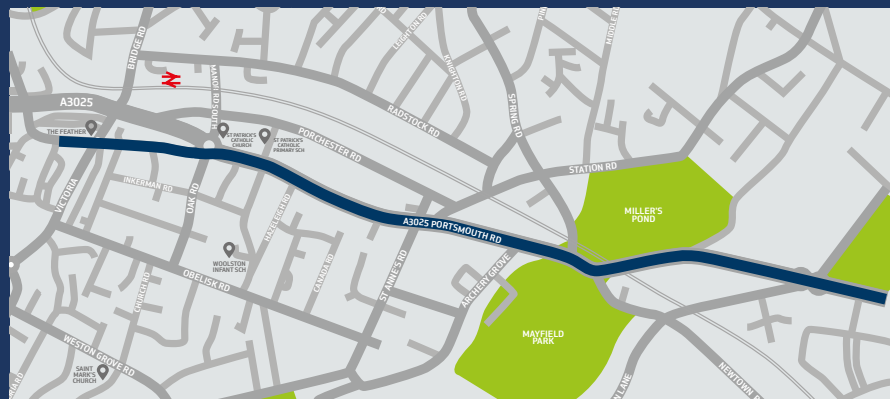

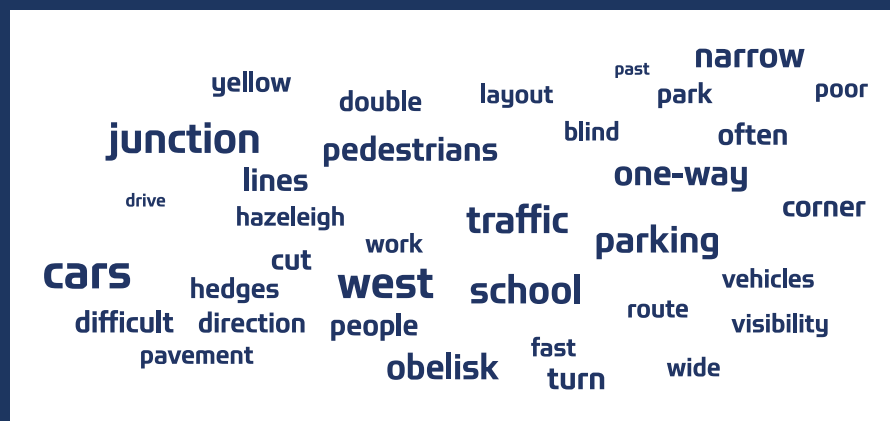

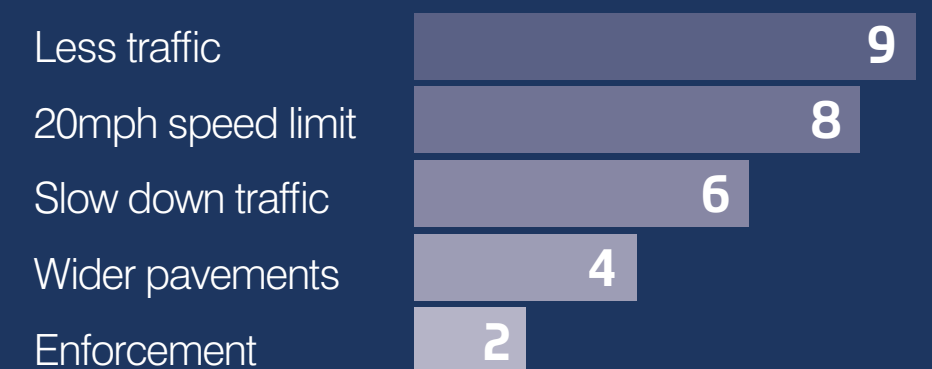

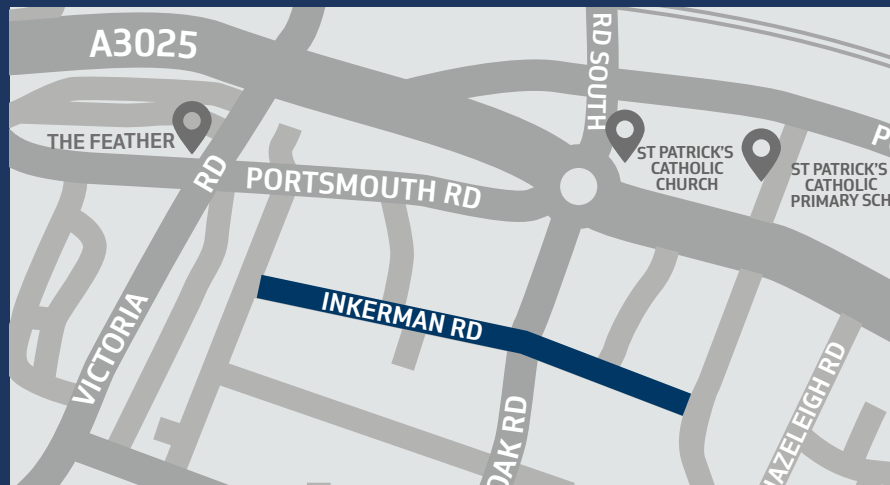
