

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AMENDMENT) (PART B) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL made the above Order on 23rd February 2022. The effects of the Order are:

1. To introduce No Waiting 8am - 6pm Monday to Friday restrictions in **Seagarth Lane**, *west side*, From 57m south of the extended south-eastern kerbline of Seagarth Close southwards for 24m.

**Note**: this Order is being introduced in parts, this is Part B. The City of Southampton (Waiting Restrictions Amendment) (Part A) Order 2021 came into operation on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

The Order comes into operation on 26th February 2022.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
