THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (VARIOUS ROADS) (MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT 30) ORDER 2022

Statement of Reasons

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (i.e. to improve safety)
- for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
- Improving air quality

As part of our Transforming Cities programme on the Eastleigh to Southampton corridor, a number of changes are proposed to improve St Denys Road (A3035). These include improved facilities for walking, cycling and bus travel; junction changes; and upgrades to traffic signals.

These proposals are to replace the existing advisory with-flow cycle lanes on Cobden Bridge with Mandatory with-flow cycle lanes. This will provide additional protection and priority to cyclists using this route.
