

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST DENY'S ROAD) (BUS PRIORITY) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To introduce a One-way restriction (traffic must travel north) on **Belmont Road**, from its junction with St Denys Road northwards for 14m.
2. To introduce a mandatory with-flow cycle lane on **St Denys Road**, *south side*, From 72m southeast of its junction Belmont Road westwards for 65m.
3. To introduce a mandatory with-flow cycle lane on **Belmont Road**, *west side*, From 28m south of its junction with St Denys Road northwards for 5m.
4. To remove the Prohibition of Buses on **Belmont Road**, between its junction with St Denys Road and Portswood Road.
5. To relocate the westbound bus stop clearway adjacent to 24/26 St Denys Road to outside 19 St Denys Road. **Note:** No waiting at any time restrictions (underlying and pre-existing) will replace the bus stop clearway.
