## Albion Place Bus Interchange, Portland Terrace & Urban Park

## **Construction dates:** Autumn 2023 to Spring 2024

Cost: £3.9M

## **Overview**

The new Albion Place bus interchange and adjacent park at Castle Way will create an exciting new space within the heart of the City Centre whilst helping to future proof bus operations to the west of the City Centre.

The scheme will increase the number of available bus stops while greatly improving public transport access into and around the City Centre.

Amenities at the interchange include:

- New waiting facilities
- Public seating
- Landscaping
- Access to e-mobility (e-scooter and cycle hire)
- Travel information

Outcomes

The scheme includes conversion of the Castle Way car park to an urban park. This will greatly enhance the public space reflecting the city's rich heritage by strengthening the connection with the historic city walls.

To prioritise access for buses to the new interchange, Portland Terrace will become bus/cycle/taxi only from Spa Road to the Shopmobility site. This will reduce traffic along Portland Terrace, contribute to an enhanced environment for people walking and cycling, and facilitate changes to Castle Way including improved crossings to the new interchange, the Old Town and West Quay.



- New bus interchange to include new waiting facilities, seating, travel information all using high quality public realm materials enhancing the old town heritage setting.
- New urban park at Castle Way car park using high quality public realm materials, landscaping features and ambient lighting to enhance the public space and reflect the city's rich heritage by strengthening the connection with the historic city walls.
- Improvements to Shopmobility including additional spaces, longer spaces for rear ramped access and improved site access.
- Improved bus access along Portland Terrace and enhanced pedestrian environment along the length of Portland Terrace bus gate.



Greatly enhanced space adjacent to the historic city walls through the creation of an urban park at Castle Way car park, and a new bus interchange at Albion Place car park to increase the number of available bus stops, which together with the Portland Terrace bus gate will significantly improve public

significantly improve public transport access into and around the City Centre.

Provide opportunities to attract additional outdoor events within the new urban park.
