

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (WOOLSTON & ITCHEN ATZ) (ROAD HUMPS) NOTICE 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 intends to construct the following road humps:

1. A flat-top raised table (75mm height) at the junction of **Radstock Road** and **Manor Road South** to facilitate a parallel crossing. On Radstock Road the road hump will start at the bus stop layby and extend westwards for 46m across Manor Road South Junction. The road hump will extend 11m into Manor Road South.
2. A flat-top raised table (75mm height) on **Obelisk Road**, immediately west of its junction with Oak Road (5m length) to facilitate a Zebra Crossing.
3. A flat-top raised table (75mm height) on **Obelisk Road**, between its junction with Cox's Lane and John's Road (5m length) to facilitate a Zebra Crossing.

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to this notice must do so in writing via the Councils website: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the notice title and, where objecting, stating the grounds for the objection, within 21 days of the date of this notice (i.e. by 23rd December 2022).
