

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (STATIC RESTRICTIONS) (WEST) (AMENDMENT 1) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in the following lengths of road:
 - a. **Howards Grove**, *south-east side*, From the south-western boundary of 93 Howards Grove to 3m north-east of the boundary between 97 Howards Grove and 99 Howards Grove and From 2m north-east of the north-eastern boundary of 137 Howards Grove to its junction with St James's Road.
 - b. **Howards Grove**, *north-west side*, From 15m north-east of the north-eastern kerblines of the car park access road opposite 129 Howards Grove north-eastwards for 4m and From 36.5m north-east of the north-eastern kerblines of the car park access road opposite 129 Howards Grove to its junction with St James's Road.
 - c. **St James's Road**, *south-west side*, From 6m north-west of the north-western kerblines of Howards Grove to 10m south-east of the south-eastern kerblines of Howards Grove.
2. To introduce permit holders only restrictions, Monday to Saturday: 8am – 6pm in **Howards Grove**, *South-east side*, From 3m north-east of the boundary between 97 Howards Grove and 99 Howards Grove to 2m north-east of the north-eastern boundary of 137 Howards Grove.

Odd number properties between 99 to 137 Howards Grove (inclusive) would be entitled to a maximum of 1 permit per property. Further details on how the scheme would operate can be found on the Council's webpage: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to this Order must do so in writing via the Council's website: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the Order title and, where objecting, stating the grounds for the objection, within 28 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by 13th January 2023). Note the consultation period has been extended by a week to account for the Christmas period.

Please note that all representations submitted, including the name and address of the person submitting it, may be made available for public inspection.
