THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (SPRING ROAD – STATION ROAD) (ROAD HUMP) NOTICE 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 intends to construct the following road humps:

LOCATION:	HEIGHT: (Millimetres)
Spring Road from 62m north of the northern kerb-line of Portsmouth Road, northward for 4m	75
Station Road from 3.5m north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Porchester Road, south-westward for 14m	75
Porchester Road at its junction with Station Road for 2.5m	75
Spring Road from 24m south its junction with Millers Pond Gardens, southward for 42m	75
Station Road from 9m east of its junction with Spring Road, westward for 24m	75

The proposed road humps are of a flat-top design.
