THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (CUTBUSH LANE) (CYCLE FACILITIES) NOTICE 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following shared use cycle tracks:

- 1. Cutbush Lane Footways (near Meggeson Avenue), *east side*, the section between Cutbush Lane footpath and the carriageway
- 2. **Benhams Road Footways,** *both sides,* the sections between Cutbush Lane Footpath and the carriageway
- 3. **Town Hill Way Footways,** *both sides,* From Cutbush Lane Footpath, southwards, linking with the existing shared-use cycle tracks
- 4. **Meggeson Avenue Footway and Verges,** *north side,* connect Town Hill Way Footways with the existing cycle facilities (approx. 16m of footway converted)

The conversions are to support a Parallel Crossing on Townhill Way proposed in a separate notice.

Note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
