## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (CUTBUSH LANE) CYCLE TRACKS ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL have made the above Order on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The effects of the Order are:

- 1. To convert the following sections of **Cutbush Lane Footpath** into shared-use cycle track (permitted use both on foot and on pedal cycles);
  - a. The section between Cutbush Lane and Benhams Road.

Note, the section of footpath between Benhams Road and Townhill Way is Bridleway. Bridleway is a right of way on horseback, foot and bicycle. The route if confirmed (implemented) will provide a shared-use cycle track between Cutbush Lane and Townhill Way.

This Order will not come into force until it is confirmed.

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to this Order must do so in writing via the Councils website: <a href="mailto:transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO">transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO</a> or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the notice title and stating the grounds for objection, within 28 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by 17th March 2023).

If no objections are received this Order will be confirmed by the Council as an unopposed Order.

Note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
