

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (VARIOUS ROADS) (SPEED LIMITS) (AMENDMENT 23) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following roads within the Newtown, Weston and Woolston area (for their entire lengths unless otherwise stated):

Archery Gardens, Archery Grove, Archery Road, Arrow Close, Ashley Crescent, Bacon Close, Barnfield Court, Bedford Avenue, Bevan Close, Bower Close, Bramley Crescent, Bramshott Road, Burghclere Road, Canada Road, Carolyn Close, Cavell Place, Church Road, College Road, Cox's Drive, Cozens Close, Crookham Road, Deeping Close, Doyle Court, Drayton Close, Duncan Close, Dundonald Close, Dyserth Close, Foxcott Close, Foxcott Close/ Fullerton Close Service Road, Fullerton Close, Glen Road, Gordon Terrace, Grateley Close, Grove Gardens, Grove Place, Hawkley Green, Hazeleigh Avenue, Holland Road, Holt Court, Hulton Close, Inkerman Road - From its junction with Oak Road to its junction with West Road, International Way, Jurds Lake Way, Kingsclere Avenue, Kipling Court, Lake Road, Lawrence Grove, Laxton Close, Longmore Avenue, Longmore Crescent, Longstock Close, Lyndock Close, Lyndock Place, Newtown Road, Obelisk Road - From its junction with West Road to its junction with St Annes Road, Penistone Close, Portsmouth Road, Poulner Close, Riversdale Close, Rothschild Close, Scott Road, Seaweed Close, Sparsholt Road (Service Road), Sparsholt Road, Squires Walk, St Annes Gardens, St Anne's Road, Staplehurst Close, Surrey Road, Swift Gardens, Swift Hollow, Swift Road, Taylor Close, Temple Gardens, Temple Road, Tenterton Avenue, Thornleigh Road, Thornycroft Avenue, Ticonderoga Gardens, Torcross Close, Unwin Close, Upper Weston Lane, Victoria Road - from its junction with Oswald Road to its junction with Jurds Lake Way, Waldegrave Close, Wallace Road – from its western junction with Kingsclere Avenue to its eastern junction with Kingsclere Avenue, Wentworth Gardens, West Road, Weston Close, Weston Grove Road - from its junction with Glen Road to its junction with Archery Road, Weston Lane - from Newton Road to its junction with Wallace Road and from its junction with Squires Walk to its junction with Weston Parade, Weston Parade, Winchfield Close, Worcester Place and Wright's Hill.

**Please note that this notice has been updated to include Archery Road, Hazeleigh Avenue and Wallace Road which were initially omitted in error.**
