## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (E-SCOOTER AND CYCLE HIRE PARKING) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

- **1.** To introduce E-scooter and cycle hire parking bays, with associated docks, in the following lengths of road:
  - a. **Bellevue Road**, *north side*, From its eastern closed end westwards for 3m (in place of the existing no waiting at any time restrictions). Intended to be a virtual rather than physical dock.
  - b. **Church Street**, *north-west side*, From 74m north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Victor Street north-eastwards for 7m.
  - c. **Clarendon Road**, *west side*, From 15m north of the northern kerbline of Oakley Road northwards for 5.5m.
  - d. **Cumbrian Way** (Service Road between the two junctions of Helvellyn Road), *south-east side*, From 0.5m north-east of the north-eastern flank wall of 39 41 Cumbrian Way south-westwards for 5.5m.
  - e. **Kent Road**, *north-east side*, From 0.5m north-west of the boundary between 124/126 Kent Road north-westwards for 5.5m
  - f. **Lawn Road**, *north side*, From 13m east of the eastern boundary of 15 Lawn Road (Lawn Brook Care Home) eastwards for 5.5m.
  - g. **Millbrook Road East**, *north side*, From 1.5m east of the extended boundary between 87/89 Millbrook Road East eastwards for 5.5m (in place of the existing no waiting at any time restrictions).
  - h. **Priory Avenue**, *south side*, From 10m east of the eastern kerbline of Priory Road eastwards for 5.5m.
  - i. **Redbridge Hill**, *north side*, From 37.5m east of the extended eastern kerbline of Walnut Grove eastwards for 9m.
  - j. **Wordsworth Road**, *south-eastern closed end*, for its entire length (in place of the existing no waiting at any time restrictions).
