

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST DENYS BUS PRIORITY) CYCLE TRACK NOTICE 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following shared-use cycle tracks (permitted use on pedal cycles and on foot):

- **St Denys Road Footway**, *south side*, From 20m east to 20m west of its junction with Priory Road
- **Priory Road Footway**, *east side*, from the southern kerb-line of St Denys Road southward for 8m
- **St Denys Road**, *south side*, From 15m west of the extended kerb-line of Adelaide Road westward for 6m

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to the notices must do so in writing via the Councils website: [transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO](https://transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO) or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the notice title and stating the grounds for objection, within 21 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023.)

Note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
