

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST DENYS BUS PRIORITY) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To introduce mandatory cycle lanes in the following locations;
 - **St Denys Road, north side**, From 15m east of Kent Road to the existing lanes on Cobden Bridge
 - **St Denys Road, south side**, From the existing cycle lanes on Cobden Bridge to 15m west of Adelaide Road
2. To remove the following 30 minute Limited Waiting, Mon-Sat, 8am-6pm restrictions in **St Denys Road, south side**;
 - Outside St Denys Parish Church
 - Outside property Nos.91 and 109 St Denys Road
3. To update the existing traffic order with cycle lane restrictions as they appear on street on Cobden Bridge

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to the notices must do so in writing via the Councils website: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the notice title and stating the grounds for objection, within 21 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by 24th March 2023.)

Note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
