

East Park Terrace Consultation Questionnaire Analysis

December 2022

Summary

- The consultation was live from 1 to 27 Nov 2022
- 330 responses were submitted
- 87% of respondents live in post code areas SO14 to SO19 and 9% in other SO postcodes
- 56% of respondents live, work or study in Southampton City Centre
- To get into the city centre, 42% of respondents most often travel by car/van, 37% use an active travel mode (20% walk/wheel, 17% cycle) and 14% travel by bus.
- To *travel around in* the city centre, 71% use an active travel mode (44% walk / wheel, 27% cycle) while 18% travel by car/van and 3% by bus.

Despite the fact that over half the respondents believe the proposal will make car/van journeys into the city centre longer (59%) and access to properties and destinations in the city centre by car/van more difficult (52%) over half of respondents support the proposal overall (57%) and 64% agreed that it will create a safer and more enjoyable environment for people walking, wheeling and cycling. More than a third (36%) would be encouraged to walk or cycle more and 24% would be encouraged to travel by bus more. Nearly half the respondents (48%) believe the proposal will help reduce congestion and air pollution.

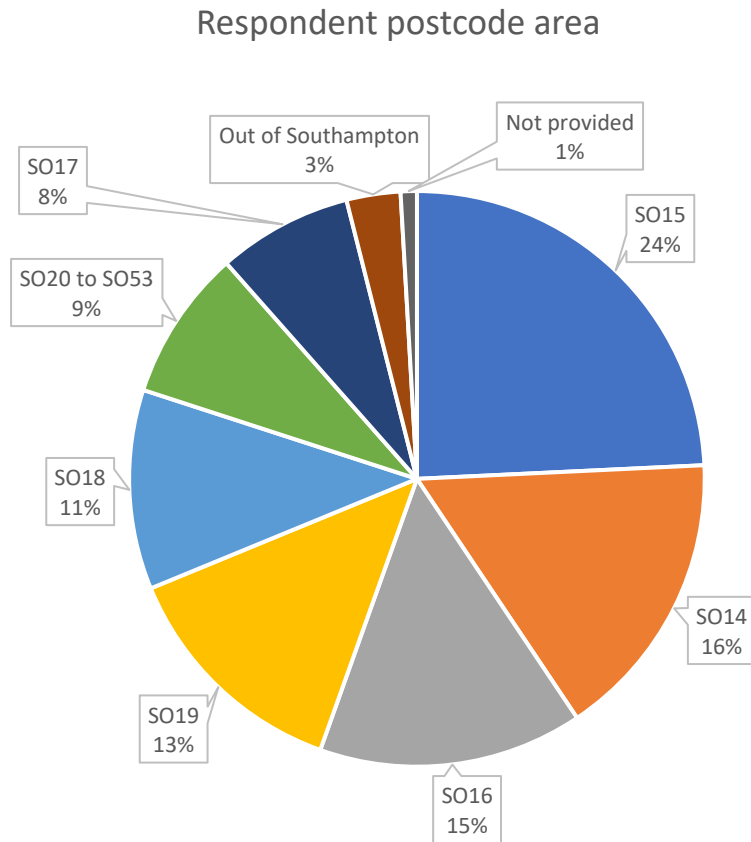
Key findings

- 57% of respondents support the proposal overall.
- 64% agreed that the proposal will create a safer and more enjoyable environment for people walking, wheeling and cycling
- 36% said the proposal will encourage them to walk or cycle more
- 24% said they would be encouraged to travel by bus more
- 48% believe the proposal will help reduce congestion and air pollution

This is despite the fact that:

- 59% believe this will make car/van journeys into the city centre longer
- 52% believe it will make it difficult to access properties and destinations in the city centre by car/van

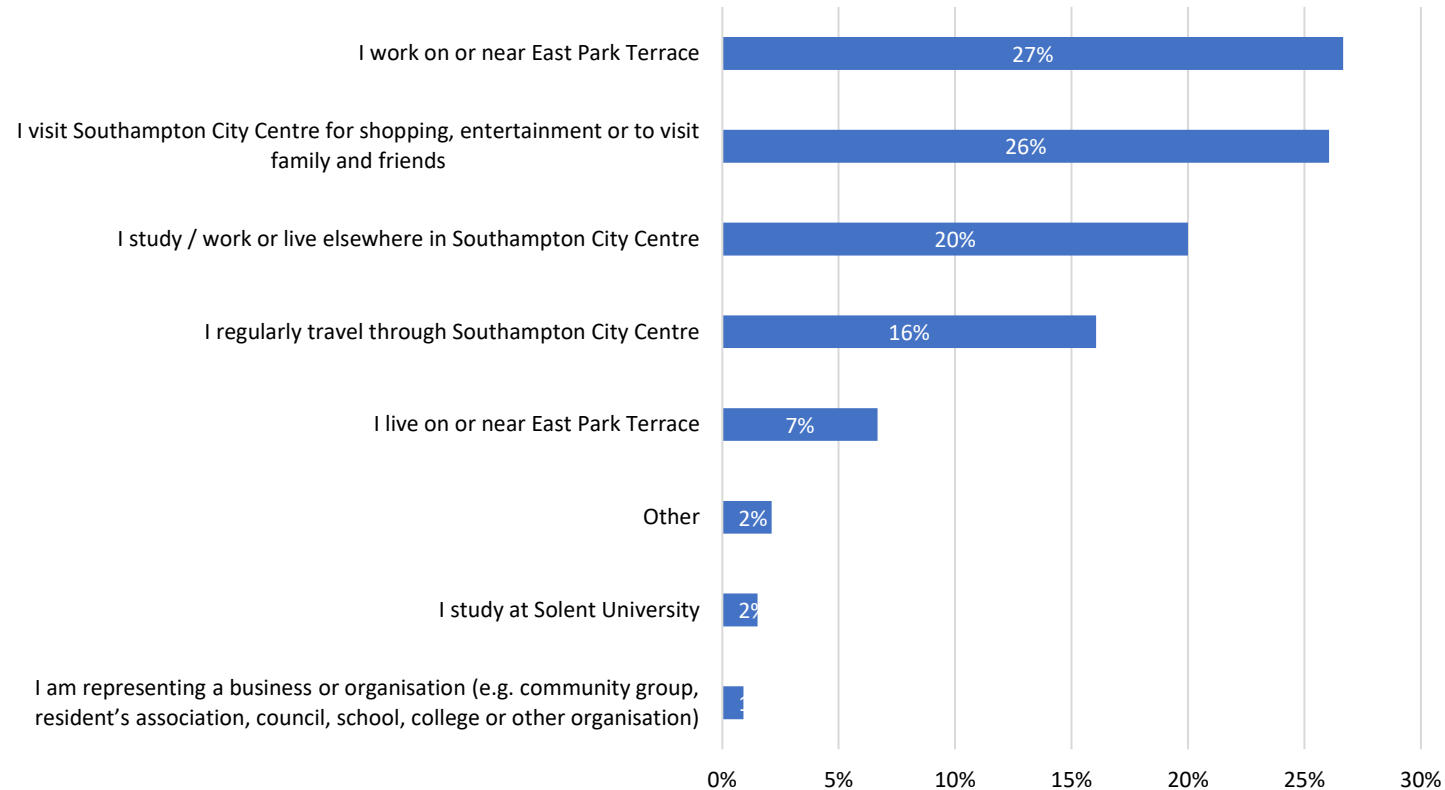
Postcode areas

- 9% live in other SO postcodes

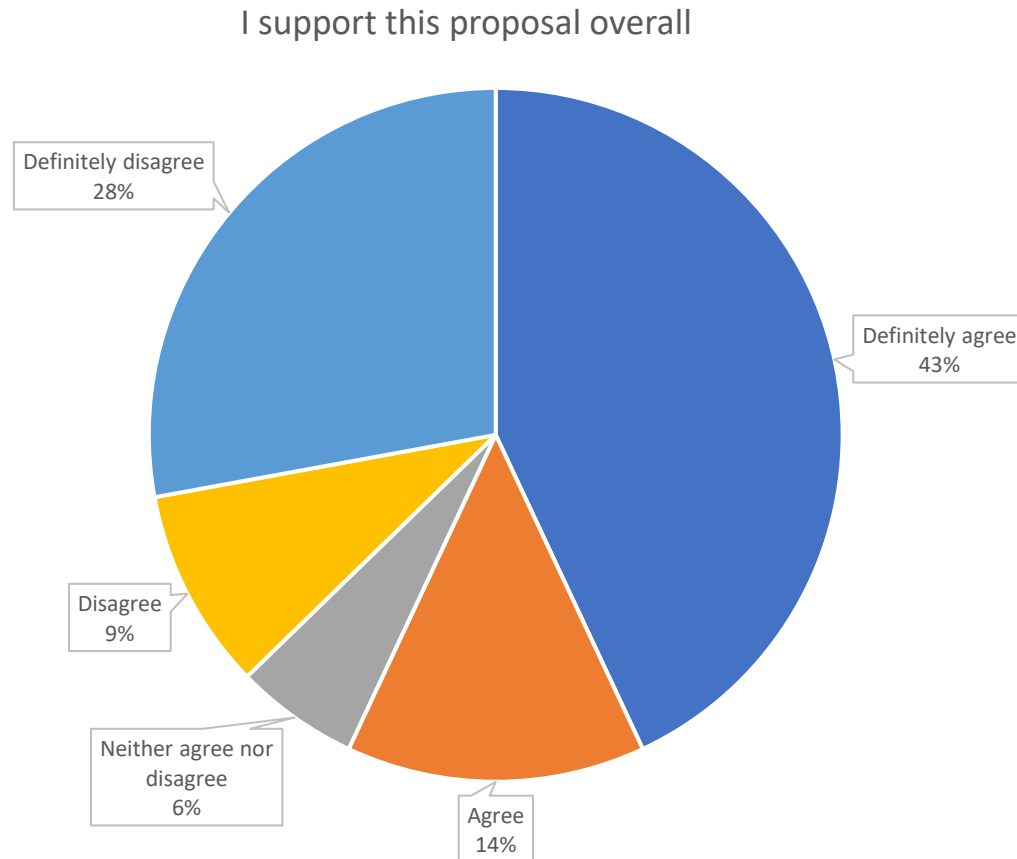
Main reason for responding

- 16% regularly travel through Southampton City Centre

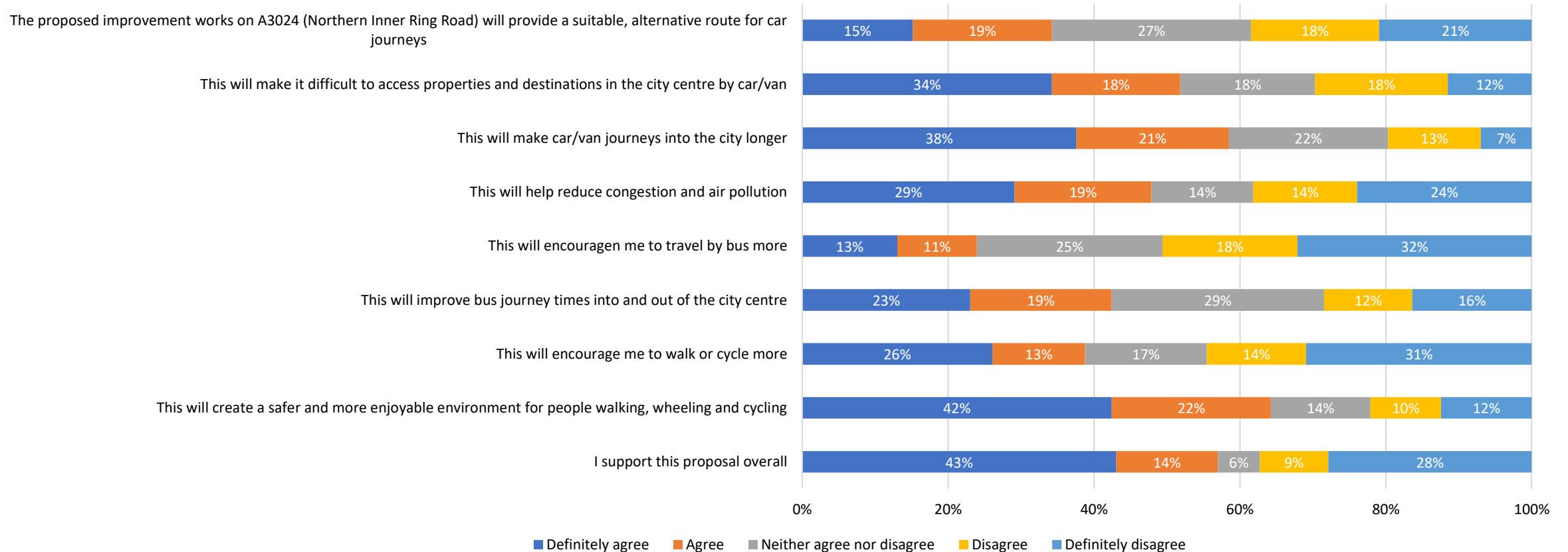
Overall support for the proposal

Thinking about the proposed changes to East Park Terrace, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements:

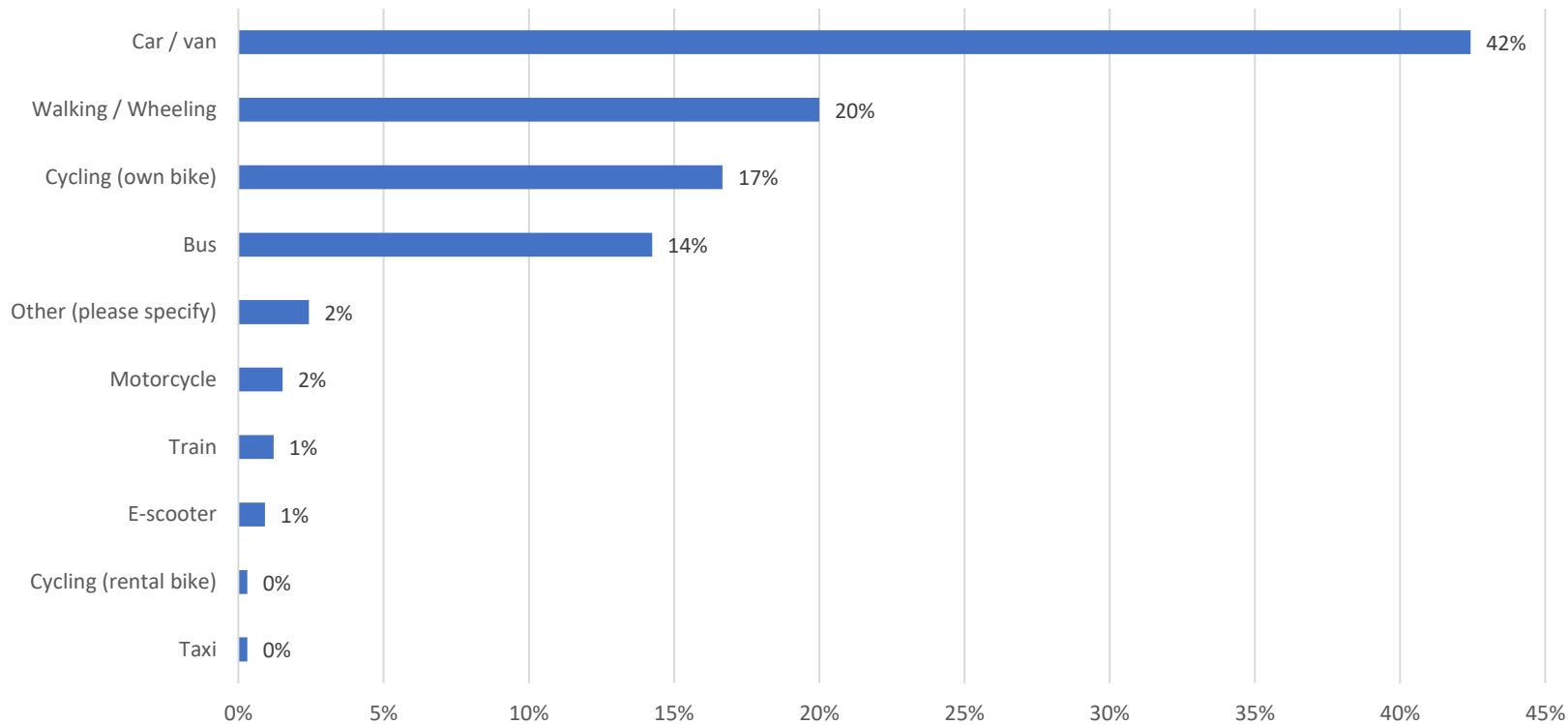


To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements...

- 64% agreed that the proposal will create a safer and more enjoyable environment for people walking, wheeling and cycling
- 36% said the proposal will encourage them to walk or cycle more
- 42% believe the proposal will improve bus journey times into and out of the city centre
- 24% said they would be encouraged to travel by bus more
- 48% believe the proposal will help reduce congestion and air pollution, 38% disagreed
- 59% believe this will make car/van journeys into the city centre longer
- 52% believe it will make it difficult to access properties and destinations in the city centre by car/van
- 34% agree the proposed improvement works on A3024 (Northern Inner Ring Road) will provide a suitable, alternative route for car journeys, 39% disagree and 27% did not express a view

What mode of transport do you use most often for getting into Southampton City Centre?

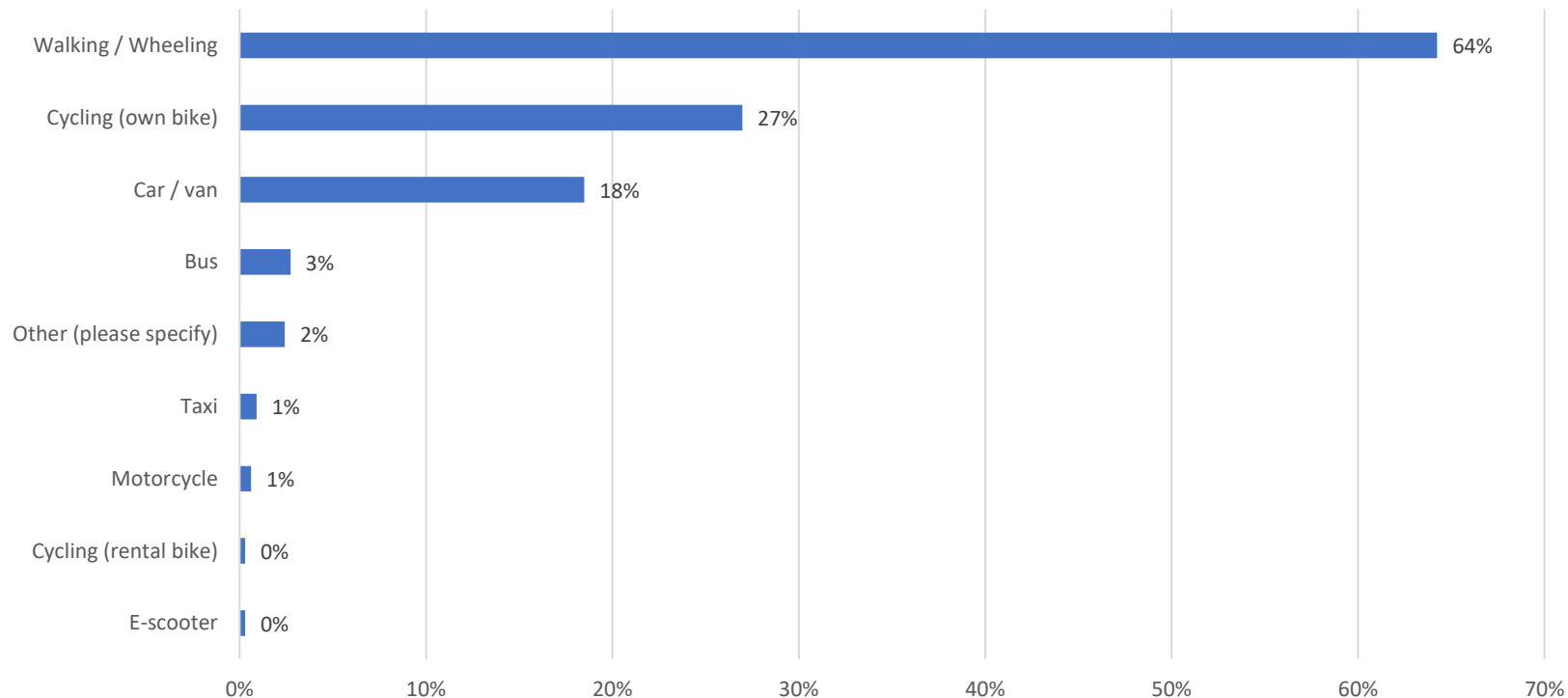
What mode of transport do you use most often for getting into Southampton City Centre?



- 42% of respondents most often travel into Southampton City Centre by car/van
- 37% most often use an active travel mode
 - 20% walk/wheel
 - 17% cycle
- 14% travel by bus

- 71% use an active travel mode to travel around the city centre:
 - 44% walk / wheel
 - 27% cycle
- 18% travel by car/van
