

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ITCHEN BRIDGE TOLLS) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL made the above Order on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2023, the effects of which will be:

1. To amend the maximum tolls for Class 2 vehicles (those with a height at first axle of no more than 1.33m - cars, small vans and small 4x4s) to £1 (peak times) and 80p (off-peak times).
2. To remove the Electric Vehicle Concession.

Note: This Order will revoke and replace The City of Southampton (Itchen Bridge Tolls) Order 2021

The order comes into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
