

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (GOLDEN GROVE) (AMENDMENT 2) ORDER 2023

Statement of Reasons

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (*i.e. to improve safety*)
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

As part of the members minor works process there has been a request for improved pedestrian crossings facilities on James Street. The removal of the parking bay is required to facilitate the installation a raised table crossing, across James Street.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
