East Park Terrace will become bus/taxi and cycle only between Charlotte Place Roundabout and the New Road / Palmerston Road junction. The section will work in conjunction with the New Road Bus Connectivity scheme.

This will allow public realm improvements along this link creating a better and more enjoyable environment for people walking and cycling. It will also create better connectivity between the university, the parks and the City Centre.

Bus journey times and journey time reliability into and out of the City Centre from Portswood will be improved with the scheme encouraging sustainable transport.



Benefits

- Improved bus journey times and bus journey time reliability along East Park Terrace for services from and to Portswood into the City Centre, providing buses with the necessary priority to access the bus hubs and City Centre bus stops.
- Creates an enhanced pedestrian environment along East Park Terrace connecting Solent University with the city centre. This connection is important in providing safer access for students walking and cycling to the site through the parks from other university locations and accommodation.



Outcomes



Support an increase in the number of people walking and cycling, and bus journeys within the wider City Centre area.



Reduce the longer-term impact on climate change and air quality through increased use of sustainable transport.



Improve the health and wellbeing of residents, including deprived communities through improved access to the parks, cultural and high street quarters.

Outputs

A sustainable transport corridor in a key area of the city, re-imagined to focus on sustainable transport and prioritising people walking and cycling.
