NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct the following footways into shared use cycle tracks:

- 1. Both arms, between 19 Starboard Way and 21-43 Starboard Way, connecting Starboard Way with existing cycle track.
- 2. Entire arm, between 86 Starboard Way and 69-85 Starboard Way, connecting Starboard Way with existing cycle track.
- 3. Entire arm, between 1 Starboard Way and 2D Fairisle Road, connecting Starboard Way with Fairisle Road.
- 4. Fairisle Road Footway, north side, between the section described in Point 3 above, eastwards to a section immediately east of Starboard Way at its junction with Fairisle Road.
