THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (HONEYSUCKLE) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

- **1.** To introduce a Bus Gate, Mon-Fri, 8-9.30am & 2.15-3.45pm on **Honeysuckle Road**, between Lilac Road and Daisy Road.
- 2. To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in place of 2hr limited waiting except for permit holders, Mon-Fri, 8am-6pm, in the following locations:
 - a. **Honeysuckle Road**, *north side*, From 1m east of the boundary between 219/221 Road eastwards to its eastern closed end*
 - b. **Honeysuckle Road,** eastern closed end*, For its entire length.
 - c. Honeysuckle Road, south side, From the eastern closed end*, westwards for 5m
 - d. **Laburnum Road,** east side, From the northern kerbline of Honeysuckle Road, northwards for 8m

*Note: Twenty metres of carriageway at the eastern closed end of Honeysuckle Road will be converted to footway. The centre of the extension will provide a two-way cycle track with grass verge on either end. See The City of Southampton (Honeysuckle Road) (Cycle Facilities) Notice 2023.
