PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (CITY CENTRE) (AMENDMENT 3) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

- 1 To introduce No waiting at any time restrictions in place of all existing No waiting during restricted hours restrictions within the City Centre Pay and Display Zone.
- 2 To introduce Pay and Display parking (8am to 8pm on all days) in the following lengths of road:
 - **High Street**, *east side*, outside number 46 47 High Street in place of the existing no waiting at any time restriction and From 61m south of the southern kerbline of Bernard Street southwards for 11m (in place of existing no waiting during restricted hours restriction).
 - **b Broad Green**, west side of eastern arm, From 33m south of the southern kerbline of Winton Street southwards for 11m (in place of existing no waiting during restricted hours restriction).
 - **c Lime Street**, *south side*, From 10m east of the eastern kerbline of Orchard Lane eastwards for 44m
 - **d** Albert Road South, north side, in place of the existing no waiting during restricted hours restriction opposite 143 Albert Road South and From 4m south-west of the extended north-eastern boundary of 133 Albert Road South south-westwards for 5.5m
- To introduce No waiting at any time restrictions in **Threefield Lane**, *west side*, From 5m north of the northern kerbline of Chandos Street northwards for 11m (in place of the existing Pay and Display Parking (two bays)). It is intended to install a bus stop clearway over the no waiting restrictions.
- To amend the restricted hours for the Pay and Display or Permit Parking (Zone 18) bays in **Rockstone**Place to 8am to 8pm on all days.
- To amend the restricted hours for the Permit Parking Only (Zone 1) bays in the following roads to 8am to 8pm on all days:
 - a Ordnance Road
 - b Bellevue Road
 - c Kings Park Road

Note it is also intended to extend the zig-zag markings (controlled area) of the pedestrian crossing on the eastern side of **Portland Terrace** between Asda and The Marlands southwards to the disabled bays.
