

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON
(VARIOUS ROADS) (STATIC RESTRICTIONS) (WEST) (AMENDMENT 5) ORDER 2024

Statement of Reasons

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic
- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s122 subsection (2) of that Act).

Southampton City Council in partnership Active Travel England have prepared a safer route to School scheme in Lords Hill near to the Fairisle Schools and Oasis Academy. To facilitate this objective, the Council are proposing a Parallel Crossing, minor parking amendments and 20mph speed limit. The footway adjacent to the crossing will be widened too.
