From 13.00, a tour by modern Euro VI compliant Bluestar bus to see the following developments:

- Portland Terrace Bus Gate and Albion Place Transport Hub
   A trip along the bus gate that opened in November 2023, and to see progress on the transport hub which will open in Autumn 2024.
- Central Station South Transport Interchange
   Opened in December 2023 and completed in conjunction with South Western Railway.
- Southampton West Park & Ride (Transforming Cities Fund) via Millbrook Road West Works completed to support bus services to the Hospital, and for the possibility of Southampton's first park & ride site at the location of the University Hospitals Southampton staff park & ride facility.
- Marchwood by-pass and Rushington Roundabout bus priority
  A new bus lane on the Marchwood Bypass approach to Rushington Roundabout together
  with a new bus gate along the A326 and associated priority signals.
- Glen Eyre Quietway including a bus gate
   Traffic calming measures and pedestrian and cyclist improvements.
