

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (BEVOIS HILL) CROSSING NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes the following:

1. To introduce a Zebra Crossing, between the footway and a floating bus stop on **Bevois Hill**, adjacent to Flat 1, Bevois Mansions property. The Crossing will facilitate pedestrians across a Mandatory with flow cycle lane.\*

\*Refer to The City of Southampton (Bevois Hill) Order 2024.

**Note:** An independent cycle signal phase is planned at the junction of Bevois Valley and Thomas Lewis Way (southern arm); enabling cyclists to either continue straight onto Bevois Valley or to cross diagonally and access the western shared-use path on Bevois Hill, connecting with the SCN6 route.
