

**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON
(MOVING TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT 2) ORDER 2024**

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on **DATE** and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment 2) Order 2024.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
- (i) “Principal Order” means The City of Southampton (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2022, as amended.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

- 3 The following definitions shall be inserted into Article 1.3 of the Principal Order:

““taxi” means a vehicle licensed under section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or section 6 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869.

“private hire vehicle” means a vehicle licensed under 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.”

- 4 The contents of Schedule B to the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

“The following vehicles or types of vehicles are authorised vehicles for the purposes of this order:

- (a) Taxis licenced by Southampton City Council,
- (b) Private hire vehicles licenced by Southampton City Council,
- (c) Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am – 9:30am and 4pm – 6:30pm only, taxis and private hire vehicles licenced by an authority other than Southampton City Council provided the vehicle was first registered on or after 1st September 2015 for diesel vehicles (reflecting the introduction of Euro 6b emission standards) or, on or after 1st January 2006 for petrol vehicles (reflecting the introduction of Euro 4 emission standards), and
- (d) A vehicle being used for a home to school service on behalf of the Council provided that any terms and conditions specified by the Council are complied with.

- (e) A vehicle being used in accordance with a written approval issued by the Council provided that any terms and conditions specified by the Council are complied with.”
