

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (PORTSWOOD ACTIVE TRAVEL ZONE) (SUPPORTING MEASURES) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL intends to undertake following measures to support of the Portswood Active Travel scheme:

1. Suspend part of the permit holders / limited waiting parking bay on **Highfield Lane**, *south-west side*, From the south-eastern boundary of the south-eastern junction of Glebe Court south-eastwards for approximately 5m. A no waiting at any time restriction will apply to the suspended section. This will facilitate the introduction of a build-out.
2. Suspend part of the permit holders / limited waiting parking bay on **Brookvale Road**, *south-east side*, From 21m north-east of the extended north-eastern kerbline of Highfield Court north-eastwards for approximately 10m. A no waiting at any time restriction will apply to the suspended section. This will facilitate the introduction of an island and priority/give-way arrangement.
3. Suspend the permit holders / limited waiting parking bay, that applies in **Brookvale Road**, *south-east side*, From 39.5m south-west of the southern kerb-line of Abbots Way south-westwards to the extended southern boundary of 40 Brookvale Road. A no waiting at any time restriction will apply to the suspended bay. This will facilitate the introduction of an island and priority/give-way arrangement.
4. Suspend part of the permit holders only parking bay on **Brookvale Road**, *north-east side*, From the boundary between 26 and 28 Brookvale Road south-eastwards for approximately 9m. A no waiting at any time restriction will apply to the suspended section. This will facilitate the introduction of a pinch point and priority/give-way arrangement.
5. Suspend part of the permit holders / limited waiting parking bays on **Russell Place**, *both sides*, From 9m south-west of the south-western kerbline of Abbots Way south-westwards for approximately 10m. A no waiting at any time restriction will apply to the suspended section. This will facilitate the introduction of a prohibition of motor vehicles restriction.

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to this notice must do so in writing via the Councils website: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO or by post to the Highways Legal Team at Southampton City Council, Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY quoting the notice title and, where objecting, stating the grounds for the objection, within 21 days of the date of this notice (i.e. by 15th November 2024).
