

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (BITTERNE ROAD EAST) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions in the following lengths of road:
 - a. **Keynsham Road**, *both sides*, From 67.5m east of the eastern kerb-line of Bath Road eastwards and southwards to 25m north of the northern kerb-line of Nursery Gardens
 - b. **Bitterne Road East**, *north side*, from 200m east of its junction with Commercial Street to of its junction with Somerset Avenue (extension of existing restrictions)
 - c. **Bitterne Road East**, *south side*, From 68m west of the extended western kerb-line of Somerset Avenue westward for 143m
2. To introduce a Contraflow Cycle Lane on **Bitterne Road East Service Road** (Leading to Milbury Crescent) From the north-western kerb-line of Bath Road, westwards for 8m
3. To introduce a Mandatory with Flow Cycle lane on **Bitterne Road East**, *south side*, From 45 m East of the western kerb-line of Sommerset Avenue to a point 35m west of the western kerb-line of Sommerset Avenue
