NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL made the above Order on 11th December 2024, the effects of which will be:

- 1. To introduce a Loading Bay for Goods Vehicles in **St Denys Road** (**Spur**), south-west side, From 38m south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Portswood Road south-eastwards for 8.5m (in place of existing no waiting at any time restrictions and limited waiting parking bay).
- 2. To otherwise align the Traffic Regulation Order with the restrictions as they appear on-street for St Denys Road and St Denys Road (Spur).

This Order will come into operation on 27th January 2025.
