

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (PORTSWOOD ACTIVE TRAVEL ZONE) (TRAFFIC CALMING WORKS) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 90G of the Highways Act 1980 and The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 has approved the implementation of the following traffic calming works :

1. A build-out on **Highfield Lane**, *south-west side*, immediately south-east of Glebe Court (eastern junction) – opposite the existing build-out on the north-east side of Highfield Lane to create a narrowed pinch point (in place of part of the existing permit holders/limited waiting parking bay).
2. An island on **Brookvale Road**, approximately 11m north-east of Highfield Close to facilitate the introduction of a priority/give-way arrangement.
3. An island on **Brookvale Road**, approximately 16m north-east of Uplands Way to facilitate the introduction of a priority/give-way arrangement.
4. An island on **Brookvale Road**, approximately 32m north-east of De Grouchy Lane to facilitate the introduction of a priority/give-way arrangement.
5. A build-out and island on **Brookvale Road**, approximately 43m north-west of Winn Road to facilitate the introduction of a priority/give-way arrangement.
6. A build-out and island on **Belmont Road**, approximately 14m north of Osborne Road South to facilitate the introduction of a priority/give-way arrangement.

The works will be undertaken in due course and are intended to be completed by 27th January 2025.
