Northam Bridge – Drainage Survey Works

Balfour Beatty is working in partnership with Southampton City Council to manage the highways service across Southampton. As part of this, we will be performing drainage surveys on Northam Bridge over a period of 5 nights, as part of our annual road maintenance programme.

This work is planned to take place from **Monday 10 February 2025**, and is expected to take 5 **nights**. During this time, a road closure will be in place on Northam Bridge between the hours of **8:00pm and 06:00am**. Please see the table below for the restrictions that will be in place during our works.

10, 11 and 12 February, between 08:00pm and 06:00am	Westbound closure in place between Rampart Road and Princes Street. The bridge will remain open in the opposite direction.
13 and 14 February between 08:00pm and 06:00am	Eastbound closure in place between Union Road and Englefield Road. The bridge will remain open in the opposite direction.

During the overnight works, a signed diversion will be in place for traffic which will use Cobden Bridge, with pedestrian access maintained throughout. In the event that works are delayed or ahead of schedule, we will alert you of any changes to the drainage survey dates using yellow 'advance warning' signs in the area. Please be aware that the dates in this letter are subject to changes, dependant on favourable weather conditions.

Properties close to the carriageway may experience a temporary disturbance such as flashing lights and reversing sirens as this can be a noisy process. We would like to take this opportunity to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption this work may cause.
