THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (STATIC RESTRICTIONS) (WEST) (AMENDMENT 6) ORDER 2025

Statement of Reasons

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic,
- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising (*i.e. to improve safety*)

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient, and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).

General

Under the Traffic Management Act 2004, s.86, vehicles can park across a vehicle access when parked within a permit parking bay, CEOs cannot issue PCNs in this context. Considering the new development will serve several parking places and access will be required for the same, it is proposed to amend the on-street parking and facilitate access.
