

Imperial Avenue - Carriageway pothole repairs

Balfour Beatty is working in partnership with Southampton City Council to manage the highways service across Southampton. As part of this, we are making pothole repairs to a portion of the road surface on Imperial Road, as part of our annual road maintenance programme.

This work is planned to take from **Tuesday 18th February 2025**, between **8:00am and 4:00pm**. During the work, there will be a road closure in place on Imperial Avenue at the junction with Benson Road, as seen in the map below.



Please be aware that the dates in this letter are subject to changes, dependant on favourable weather conditions. In the event that works are delayed or ahead of schedule, we will alert you of any changes to the construction dates using yellow 'advance warning' signs in the area.

Prior to the start of the works, we will reserve the works area using 'no-waiting' cones; **please do not park where you see these cones** as we may need to remove vehicles which block access to our works.



Pedestrian access to the walkway between Imperial Avenue and Lemon Road will be maintained.

We would like to assure you that we will facilitate refuse collection during this time, however if you do experience any changes to your access needs or are expecting any large deliveries, please speak to the team once they arrive on site and they will do their best to accommodate you.

Properties close to the carriageway may experience a temporary disturbance such as flashing lights and reversing sirens as this can be a noisy process. We would like to take this opportunity to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption this work may cause.
