Linacre Road / Tatwin Crescent / Proctor Close / Medwall Green

Balfour Beatty is working in partnership with Southampton City Council to manage the highways service across Southampton. As part of this, we are undertaking improvements in 4 different areas, as part of our annual road maintenance programme. These works are planned to start Monday 12 May 2025, with road closures and phased footway closures required for the duration. Please see the table below for the works schedule:

Proctor Close	Civil works	Wednesday 14 May, expected to take 3 days

Linacre Road	Footway surface treatment	Wednesday 11 June, expected to take 2 days.
Tatwin Crescent	Footway surface treatment	Wednesday 11 June, expected to take 4 days.
Proctor Close	Footway surface treatment	Friday 13 June, expected to take 3 days.
Medwall Green	Footway surface treatment	Monday 16 June, expected to take 3 days.

Working hours will be between 7:30am – 5:30pm, and the restrictions will be in place only during working hours.

Please be aware that the dates in this letter are subject to changes, dependant on favourable weather conditions. In the event that works are delayed or ahead of schedule, we will alert you of any changes to the construction dates using yellow 'advance warning' signs in the area.

Prior to the start of the works, we will reserve the works area using 'no-waiting' cones; please do not park where you see these cones as we may need to remove vehicles which block access to our works.

Please note, to minimise disruption to residents we are not intending to work at weekends; however should we experience any delays then it may be necessary to work on Saturdays.



We would like to assure you that we will facilitate refuse collection during this time, however if you do experience any changes to your access needs or are expecting any large deliveries, please speak to the team once they arrive on site and they will do their best to accommodate you.

Properties close to the carriageway may experience a temporary disturbance such as flashing lights and reversing sirens as this can be a noisy process. We would like to take this opportunity to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption this work may cause.
