Upcoming Roadworks on Derby & Clovelly Road (17 February – 7 April 2025)

We are writing to inform you about important upcoming roadworks on Clovelly Road and Derby Road, scheduled to take place from late January to mid-March 2025. These works are part of a significant upgrade to the local electrical network, aimed at improving power supply, increasing reliability, and supporting Southampton's transition to greener energy.

What is happening and when?

We will be digging trenches and installing new fluid-filled electrical cables along Derby Road and Clovelly Road. These cables will replace older ones, improving the performance and energy efficiency of the area's electrical network.

- **Derby Road (17 February – 17 March)**

Following the above process, trenching and cable installation will be carried out in 50-metre sections along one side of the road. To minimise disruption, we intend to carry out works in front of Maytree Infant School first, during half term. Rolling parking suspensions will be in place.

- **Clovelly Road (13 March – 7 April)**

Once our work on Derby Road is complete, we will begin at the Charlotte Place end of Clovelly Road, up to Exmoor Road, finishing at Derby Road. We will work in 50-metre sections, with rolling parking suspensions in place.

Why Is This Work Being Done?

These works are part of a larger initiative by Scottish and Southern Energy Network (SSEN), aimed at supporting Southampton on its journey to Net Zero. The upgrade of the local electrical network is an important step in assisting the area's transition to greener, more sustainable energy sources, while also improving the reliability and efficiency of power supply and reducing energy loss.

What to Expect:

- **Traffic and Access:** There will be temporary road or lane closures and restricted access during the works, but we will do our best to minimise disruptions. Please be prepared for some delays during this important project.
- **Work Hours:** Work will take place 8 AM - 5 PM, Monday - Sunday, as directed by Southampton City Council to minimise duration of disruption. While we will try to keep noise levels low, some disturbance may be unavoidable during working hours.
- **Access to properties:** We will ensure that access to your property is maintained. There may be disruption on the pavement outside, but this will be kept to a minimum and will not exceed 50 metres at any time.
