

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (ST MONICA SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOL) CYCLE FACILITIES NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with section 65 and section 66 of the Highways Act 1980 intends to construct shared use cycle tracks in the following locations:

1. **South East Road Footways**, *south-west side*, from 10m south-east of the existing south-eastern kerbline of St Monica Road north-westwards for 14m (part conversion of existing footway, part new extension of footway surface)
2. **St Monica Road Footways**, *south-east side*, From its junction with South East Road Footways south-westwards for 19m. (part conversion of existing footway, part new extension of footway surface)
