THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT 3) ORDER 2025

Statement of Reasons

Southampton City Council are proposing to change the Mayflower Park Car Park to a "pay on foot" car park with barrier-controlled entry/exit.

This is intended to better control and manage access to the car park.

The charges are being amended to align with the new barrier control system. Charges within car parks are intended to manage demand, support vehicle turnover and encourage use of alternative sustainable transport options where possible.

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s122 subsection (2) of that Act).
