THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (CITY CENTRE RING ROAD) (RED ROUTE) ORDER 2025

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 35, 45, 46, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

This Order shall come into operation on [DATE] and may be cited as The City of Southampton (City Centre Ring Road) (Red Route) Order 2025.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order 1" means The City of Southampton (City Centre) Order 2022, as amended.
 - (ii) "Principal Order 2" means The City of Southampton (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2011, as amended.
 - (iii) "Principal Order 3" means The City of Southampton (Residents Parking) (Zones 1-12 & 16) Order 2014, as amended.
 - (iv) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (v) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

- 3 The content of Article 3.1 of Principal Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "The lengths of road specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedules 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 are designated as parking places (hereinafter referred to as "on-street parking places").
- **4** The following definitions shall be inserted into Article 1.7 of Principal Order 1:
 - ""Motor Car" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, not being a Motorcycle or an Invalid Carriage, which is constructed itself to carry a load or passengers and of which the weight unladen -
 - (a) if it is constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects, is adapted to carry not more than 7 passengers exclusive of the driver, and is fitted with tyres of such type as may be specified in regulations made by the Secretary of State, does not exceed 3050 kilograms;
 - (b) if it is constructed or adapted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden of any description, does not exceed 3050 kilograms (or 3500 kilograms if the vehicle carries a container or containers for holding, for the purposes of its propulsion, any fuel which is wholly gaseous at 17.5 degrees Celsius under a pressure of 1.013 bar or plant and materials for producing such fuel); or
 - (c) in a case falling within neither of the foregoing paragraphs, does not exceed 2540 kilograms."
 - "Motorcycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an Invalid Carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms."

"Invalid Carriage" means a mechanically propelled vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person"

5 The following shall be inserted into Principal Order 1 after Article 3.50:

"PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING FOR MOTOR CARS ONLY

- 3.51 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or be left in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 13 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule 13 unless the appropriate charge for the length of stay has been paid and the vehicle is a Motor Car.
- 3.52 The charge described in article 3.51 shall be as specified in schedule A with reference to the tariff applying to the on-street parking places as specified in column 7 of schedule 13.
- 3.53 The charge described in article 3.51 shall be payable by:
 - (a) the insertion into a Parking Meter which relates to the on-street parking place of coins or notes (where such a facility is available); or
 - (b) credit or debit card at a Parking Meter which relates to the on-street parking place (where such a facility is available); or
 - (c) use of a pay by phone, pay by text or pay by app system (where such a facility is available).
- 3.54 Where a Parking Ticket has been issued from a Parking Meter it must be displayed, in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle, or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle. Multiple Parking Tickets shall not be displayed.
- 3.55 The time at which the length of stay paid for will expire shall be as specified:
 - (a) on the Parking Ticket issued by the Parking Meter; or
 - (b) on a hand-held device which indicates when a charge has been paid by phone, text or app
- 3.56 A Parking Ticket shall cease to be valid at the time specified on it.
- 3.57 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or be left in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 13 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule 13 after the length of stay paid for has expired pursuant to article 3.55.
- 3.58 The length of stay paid for shall not be extended beyond the initial period (i.e. no meter feeding). For the avoidance of doubt this article applies even if such an extension would not cause the vehicle to wait for a period of time longer than the maximum stay period.
- 3.59 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or be left in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 13 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule for longer than the period of time specified in column 5 of schedule 13.
- 3.60 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle waiting or left in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 13 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule to return to that on-street parking place within the period of time specified in column 6 of schedule 13.
- 3.61 Nothing in articles 3.51, 3.57, 3.58, 3.59 or 3.60 shall apply to a vehicle waiting or left in the following circumstances:
 - (a) to allow the picking up or setting down of passengers.
 - (b) to allow the opening or closing of a gate or barrier at an entrance which the vehicle requires access to or has just exited.

- (c) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus, for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
- (d) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
- (e) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of a Statutory Undertaker in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
- (f) the vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle.

SHARED USE: NO STOPPING EXCEPT TAXIS AND FOR LOADING

- 3.62 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 14 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule 14, unless that vehicle is a taxi or is stopped for the purpose of loading or unloading goods.
- 3.63 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle stopped for the purpose of loading or unloading goods in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 14 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule 14 to wait for longer than the period of time specified in column 5 of schedule 14.
- 3.64 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle stopped for the purpose of loading or unloading goods in the on-street parking places specified in columns 1, 2 and 3 of schedule 14 during the hours specified in column 4 of schedule 14, to return to that on-street parking place within the period of time specified in column 6 of schedule 14.
- 3.65 Nothing in articles 3.62, 3.63 or 3.64 shall apply to a vehicle waiting or left in the following circumstances:
 - (a) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus, for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
 - (b) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
 - (c) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of a Statutory Undertaker in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place."
- The following shall be inserted into Principal Order 1 after Article 6.2 as a new "PART SEVEN RED ROUTES":

"NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME (RED ROUTE)

- 7.1 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 15.
- 7.2 Nothing in article 7.1 shall apply to a vehicle stopping in the following circumstances:
 - (a) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction of traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the road, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, or of

- any main, pipe or apparatus, for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place.
- (b) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place
- (c) the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of a Statutory Undertaker in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for this purpose in any other place."
- 7 The contents of Schedule 1 shall be deleted from Schedule 1 of Principal Order 1.
