

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (PARKING PERMIT CHARGES AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL proposes to make the above Order, the effects of which would be:

1. To amend the charges for parking permits within Residents Parking Zones 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 26 and 27 as set out below:

	Resident Permit	Temporary Permit	Annual Visitor Permit	Visitor Scratch Cards
Current charge	£30	£15	£30	£6 (book of 10)
Proposed charge	£45	£20	£45	£12 (book of 10)

2. To amend the charges for parking permits within Residents Parking Zones 18 and 23 as set out below:

	Resident Permit	Temporary Permit	(Zone 23 only) Visitor Scratch Cards
Current charge	£60	£15	£6 (book of 10)
Proposed charge	£85	£20	£12 (book of 10)

3. To amend the charges for parking permits as set out below, for the zones in which they are available:

	Medical Permits	Business Permits
Current charge	£30	2 weeks - £14 4 months - £115 12 months - £306
Proposed charge	£60	2 weeks - £20 4 months - £165 12 months - £435

4. For Residents Parking Zones 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 26 and 27, to amend the maximum stay period for the Annual Visitor Permit from 8 hours to 4 hours.
