## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (FOUNDRY LANE SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOL) ROAD HUMPS NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 intends to construct the road humps described below:

Foundry Lane & English Road/ Heysham Road	Junction raised table	100	25.5 & 24
Imperial Avenue/ English Road	Junction raised table	100	23 & 27
Foundry Lane	From 15m north of its northern kerbline with Henry Road	100	3
Foundry Lane	From 76m north of its northern kerbline with Heysham Road	100	3
