

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (FOUNDRY LANE SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOL) (TRAFFIC CALMING WORKS) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL in accordance with Section 90G of the Highways Act 1980 and The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 intends to construct the following traffic calming works:

1. A pinch point on **Foundry Lane**, *both sides*, from approximately 21m north to 9m south of its junction with Heysham Road and English Road.
2. A build-out on **English Road**, *south side*, from its junction with Foundry Lane westwards for approximately 12m.
3. A pinch point on **English Road**, *both sides*, from approximately 15m east to 12m west of its junction with Imperial Avenue.

Any person wishing to object or make any other representation relating to this notice must do so in writing via the Councils website: transport.southampton.gov.uk/TRO or by post to the Traffic Regulation Team at Balfour Beatty Living Places, City Depot, First Avenue, Southampton, SO15 0LJ quoting the notice title and, where objecting, stating the grounds for the objection, within 21 days of the date of this notice (i.e. by 23rd April 2026).
